Each year, beginning in October, Career Services conducts a survey of its recent graduates. **The survey gathers information about graduates' employment, job search activities, education plans and status, and their assessments of their career preparation.**

The following report provides

- a summary compilation of the 2006 survey results
- lists of graduates' job titles and employers by programs
- a list of colleges or universities that graduates are presently attending
- a list of graduates employed at internship sites
- a list of Vermont employment sites of 2006 graduates

Please note that given the varying numbers of graduates and returned surveys from each program this report only provides aggregate data.

PLACEMENT DATA

- 97% (165 of 170 respondents) *reported that they were employed or were continuing their education*
- 95% (162 of 170 respondents) *reported that they obtained employment or were continuing their education within 6 months of graduation*
 - 14 of the 162 (9 %) obtained employment at their internship sites prior to graduation
 - 4 of the 162 (3 %) obtained employment at their internship sites within 2 months of graduation
 - 2 of the 162 (1 %) obtained employment at their internship sites within 6 months of graduation
- 83 % (170 of 205 graduates) returned graduate surveys

CAREER PREPARATION & POTENTIAL

- 75 % (52 of 69 respondents) cited *internship and/or coop experience as positively affecting their employment potential*
 - 20 are working at their internship sites
 - 3 received offers to work at their internship sites but declined the offers
- 84% (76 of 91 respondents) reported that Lyndon had *provided good to excellent preparation for their jobs*
- In response to “*which of the following skills did you develop or enhance as a result of your college education?*”
 - 88% (79 of 90 respondents) identified *written and oral communication skills*
 - 70% (63 of 90 respondents) identified *critical thinking skills*
 - 59 % (53 of 90 respondents) identified *information literacy*
 - 59 % (53 of 90 respondents) identified *quantitative reasoning*
 - 36 % (32 of 90 respondents)identified *community service*
- In response to “*what was the single most important aspect of your college education?*”
 - 29% (23 of 80 respondents) said that it *gave me strong skills that will be useful in any work that I do*
 - 23% (18 of 80 respondents) said that it *made me more knowledgeable in many ways*
 - 21% (17 of 80 respondents) said that it *helped me prepare for a job*
 - 13 % (10 of 80 respondents) said that it *helped me to know myself*
 - 11% (9 of 80 respondents) said that it *helped me define my vocational goals and personal interests*
 - And another 3 % said that it *helped me to get along with other*
- 70 % (58 of 83 respondents) indicated that *their extracurricular or co-curricular activities helped prepare them for life after Lyndon*
- 77 respondents identified how faculty advisors assisted them
 - 61 % (47 of 77) *received help with course selection and constructing schedules*
 - 44 % (34 of 77) *were encouraged to explore new horizons*
 - 47 % (36 of 77) *saw their advisors as mentors*
 - 48 % (37 of 77) *received support in obtaining an internship*
 - 25% (19 of 77) *received assistance with setting personal goals*
 - 45% (35 of 77) *received assistance with career &/or educational planning*

CAREER PREPARATION & POTENTIAL continued

- 71% (72 of 102 respondents) indicated that *their jobs had definite or possible career potential*
- 80 % (121 of 151 respondents) noted that their work was *somewhat or directly related to their majors*
- 20 % (30 of 151 respondents) indicated that their work was not related to their majors
 - 16 searched for but could not locate degree related employment
 - 13 graduates didn't look for work that related to their majors
 - and 1 found better paying jobs in other fields
- 87% (76 of 87 respondents) noted that *they were satisfied with their lives at this point in time*
- 45% (51 of 114 respondents) *changed their majors while attending LSC*

JOB SEARCH

- 84 % (90 of 107 respondents) *contacted under 25 employers* before obtaining employment
- 50 % (51 of 103 respondents) conducted their job searches within a 50 mile radius of their hometowns.
- 44 % (43 of 97 respondents) used direct application to employers or newspaper advertisements to obtain employment.
- 34 % (33 of 97 respondents) used the Internet or family or friends to obtain employment
- 20 % (21 of 103 respondents) conducted broader job searches throughout the continental US

SALARY INFORMATION

- 66 % (63 of 96 respondents) reported salaries ranging from \$20,000 to over \$30,000:
 - 17 %: \$20,000-24,999
 - 23 %: \$25,000-29,999
 - 26 %: over \$30,000

FURTHER EDUCATION

- 73 % (81 of 111 respondents) *intend to seek further education sometime during their careers*
- 23 graduates are presently continuing their education

DEMOGRAPHICS

- 66% (109 of 165 respondents) are working or residing or attending school in VT
 - 88 % (96 of 109) are Vermonters remaining in Vermont
 - 12 % (13 of 109) originated from out-of-state and are remaining in Vermont
- 34% (56 of 165 respondents) are working or residing or attending school out- of -state
 - 64% (36 of 56) are Vermonters
 - 36% (20 of 56) originated from out-of-state
- 8 % (13 of 165 respondents) are working or attending college outside of Northeast and NY states.
- 22 % (28 of 130 respondents) were 25 years of age or older.
- 62 % respondents were female; 38 % were male
